Such insurance shall cover bodily injury, illnesses including but not limited to positive COVID-19 cases, medical and hospitalisation/quarantine expenses incurred in the host country, and all expenses and costs associated with repatriating the injured/ill party to its country of residence. Please check to make sure you have adequate insurance in place.
Indemnity	To the extent permitted by applicable law, all players and members of the national delegation shall release the BWF, the local partner and their respective officers, officials, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all liability, damage, loss, cost, or expense that such players and members of the national delegation may incur as a result or in connection with their participation to the tournament.
