Sport for Mobility: Para Sport Equipment Grant

Dear National Paralympic Committee,

We are thrilled to share with you another programme offering as part of the Sport for Mobility (SfM) project: the Para Sport Equipment Grant. This Grant provides resources to NPCs to support Para athletes by providing access to essential equipment for training and development.

Your NPC is invited to apply for this Para Sport Equipment Grant which features two categories: (1) a non-competitive Grant of up to EUR 10,000 focussing on winter and summer sports and (2) a competitive Grant of up to EUR 10,000 focussing solely on winter sports. Applications must be submitted using the online application form, the link to which is included in the Grant guidelines provided as an attachment to this letter.

The key details for this Grant are as follows:

- **Application period** : 18 December 2025 to 13 February 2026
- **Funding disbursement** : Once both the applicant NPC and IPC have signed the Grant Agreement, IPC will transfer 80 per cent of the total approved amount within 30 days. The remaining 20 per cent will follow within 30 days of the IPC's approval of the final report
- **Implementation period** : 1 April 2026 to 30 October 2026
- **Reporting deadline** : The Para Sport Equipment Grant final narrative and financial reports are due on 30 November 2026

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All eligible NPCs are receiving the Para Sport Equipment Grant Guidelines together with this letter. More information on the application requirements can be found in the Grant guidelines.

I hope that this Grant can positively contribute to much needed Para sport equipment in your territory, and to your efforts to support Para athletes in reaching their full potential.
